GRADUATE STUDENT AWARDS APPLICATION INFORMATION

I: ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION

The applicant:

- must be a CCWH member;
- must be a woman graduate student in a U.S. institution;
- must have passed to A.B.D. status by the time of the application;
- may hold this award and others simultaneously;
- need not attend the award ceremony to receive the award.

Additional eligibility for Berkshire Award only.

The applicant:

- must be a woman graduate student in a history department in a U.S. institution;
- may specialize in any field of history

Additional eligibility for Ida B. Wells Award only.

The applicant:

- may specialize in any field, but must be working on an historical project;
- working on a project involving issues of race is particularly welcome.

II: APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Candidates should submit ALL of the following items in one package to the same address (faxed or e-mailed documents will not be accepted):

- 6 copies of the completed application form (with abstract inside the provided space on the application form) and the signature (on the application form) of a representative of the applicant's History Department verifying that qualifying exams have been passed or that A.B.D. status has been achieved in some other way.
- 6 copies of a Curriculum Vitae
- 6 copies of a Statement describing the proposed dissertation (limit: 3 pages, single-spaced). The statement should discuss the project's central argument, its contribution to the field, its methodology and range of sources, and the author's timetable for completion.
- 6 copies each of 2 letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes, enclosed with the candidate's application .
- a self-addressed, stamped postcard, with the statement "Your CCWH/Berkshire graduate student award application has been received."
